7. OFFSITE RECYCLING - Check 'Yes' if the recyclable material is recycled at an faciltiy other than the one at which it was generated.

Check 'No' if the material is generated and recycled at the same facility. Additionally, indicate the role of the reporting facility. Check the box for each appropriate activity under taken by the facility during the generation, handling and/or recycling of the material.
504. OFFSITE GENERATOR NAME - If the generator is different from the recycler, enter the name of the person that generated the recyclable material. Complete a separate report for each generator.
505. OFFSITE GENERATOR EPA ID NUMBER - Enter the generator's 12-character U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) identification number. If the generator needs but does not yet have an identification number, the owner or operator can apply at https://dtsc.ca.gov/apply-for-hazardous-waste-epa-id-number/.
